

DO YOU HAVE AN ESCAPE ROUTE?

A highway escape route is a direct and immediate path you can take to escape oncoming traffic during a dangerous road situation to prevent or lessen the possibility of injury and property damage.



- 1 Always have an escape route in mind when stopped in traffic on the highway.
- 2 Activate your hazard lights until traffic behind you slows down.
- 3 Make sure you can always see the tires of the car in front of you to allow enough room to escape to shoulder.
- 4 Focus 90% on traffic behind you until you have at least one car stopped behind.
- 5 Continue to be prepared for an escape until you have 5 cars stopped behind you.
- 6 Avoid having trucks follow you on the highway.
- 7 Make sure your family understands the risk and how to be prepared—especially teen drivers!
